As a tribute to our 85th Anniversary, here is a little historical tidbit about the G UW from an oral history we found at the library:

"We were there (YMCA) for a number of years until one day Mr. William Hays came in and said, "How would you like to have that little house on the corner of Lafayette Court?" I said, "I think we'd like it very much. What's the proposition? Well, Major General Arthur H. Carter owned that property. It wasn't a house then; it was just really a one-story real estate office. And he wanted to give it as a tax deduction, and so he agreed to give us the buildings and land over a three-year period.
