Over the last several weeks, the committee has scheduled meetings with three board candidates in an attempt to determine their interest in joining the board.

As previously mentioned, the immediate goal of the Nominating Committee is to find a replacement for Jeff Evans and Anne Franscioni, both departing this summer.

We believe that one of our candidates, Nicole Kwasniewski, would make an excellent addition to the board and can fill the void that Anne Franscioni will leave upon her departure.

Nicole Kwasniewski Bio

Nicole is very familiar with the Greenwich United Way, having served on several event committees over the last few years. Nicole served on the Brew Ha Ha Committee in 2016 and as a co-chair in 2017. She served as a Sole Sisters Committee Member this past spring. Nicole also coordinated the GUW Shoe Drive at Christ Church Nursery School in 2017 and 2018. This fall, Nicole will be a Gala Member for the 2018 GUW Gala. She will also serve as a Reading Champions volunteer in the fall of 2018.

In addition to her work with the Greenwich United Way, Nicole is currently serving as the Executive Board President for Christ Church Nursery School (2017/2018). Nicole is also serving as the Media Coordinator for Cos Cob School and will be serving as the VP of Nominating for Cos Cob School PTA this fall (2018/2019)

Nicole's background in event planning, strong record of volunteer work, organization and passion for the mission and vision of the Greenwich United Way is clear. For these reasons, **the Committee is presenting Nicole at the June Board Meeting to fill the vacancy being created by Anne Franscioni in July. If approved by majority vote of the Board of Directors, Nicole is able to join the board immediately.**

The committee will continue to assess and meet with potential board candidates over the coming weeks and will continue to solicit board feedback on potential candidates. At the May board meeting, each board member was asked to give names of potential board candidates.
