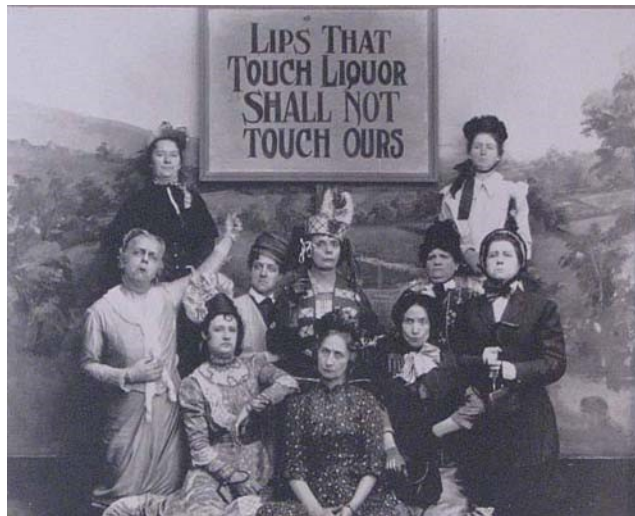


Fun Facts about Prohibition:

It was never illegal to drink during Prohibition. Prohibition barred the making of alcohol, selling it, and shipping it for the purposes of consumption. Women's Christian Temperance Union (WCTU) was one of the major forces behind the 18th Amendment. They taught as "scientific fact" that the majority of beer drinkers die from edema (swelling of the organs or body).

 - Our weekly marketing meetings with Sarah Bamford continue to strategize ways to raise awareness of G UW.
 - G UW weekly staff meetings are held every Monday at 2p (management plan review and individual updates).
 - The priorities we continue to focus on are CIP, CPC, DIP fundraising, Annual Campaign, ECAGS implementation, Champions, and the upcoming G UW events (Gala, future screenings of *Resilience*, *Sole Sisters*, etc.).
