F U N D

- Made outreaches to connect with potential COVID-19 Fund donors.
- Have raised ~\$841k to date for G UW Covid-19 Community Relief Fund (p l s n o) This includes \$80k received for Greenwich Comes Together, a nfp established that needed a 501(c)3 to administer funds. G UW agreed to act as the “pass thru”. (\$761k is grantable).

C O M M U N I T Y

- Appeared on WGCH to discuss Covid-19 Fund and role G UW is playing in town on 4/24 and 5/5.
- Weekly CEO call continues (now includes all stakeholders: TOG, GPS, Housing Dept., and others) to discuss and address concerns, needs, etc. That call has produced several positive outcomes:
 - Connected GPS to Greenwich Alliance for Education for a book program and a follow – up remote curriculum
 - Through efforts of G UW, Mothers for Others was able to move their entire diaper inventory to 2 agencies for distribution as M/F/O temporarily had to close their facility
 - Connected Greenwich Country Day School to JFS, Commission on Aging and River House for GCDS initiative to make masks for seniors.
- Numerous calls with organization CEO’s regarding grants, volunteers, programs, etc.
- Attended via Zoom Junior League of Greenwich annual Community Advisory Board meeting.
- Attended Zoom Community Development Block Grant meeting.
- Met with Carmel Academy leadership twice and discussed ways we can partner. More to follow on this. Set up by Joui Hessel.
- Discussed ways to get summer food to the GPS families on F/R/L with Toni Jones (GPS superintendent) and PTAC president.
- Participated in G UW’s “One Table, One Town” event. Hope you did, too!
- Attended CT UW discussion on budgets, staffing as they relate to crisis.
- Grants Committee met 4/21, 4/23, 5/1, 5/5, and 5/7 to rapidly deploy funding. Hats off to this committee for their dedication.
- Continuing process of opening new childcare center at St. Roch. Children’s Day School is still reviewing info.
- CEO is checking mail and making banking deposits regularly, sending the data to G UW team and DeCruze so financials can remain current. (I am in office alone every day).
